Part 3 Activities around onomatopoeias

It is said that there are hundreds of onomatopoeias in Japanese. Onomatopoeias help the listener or reader imagine the details of situations you describe. Also, onomatopoeias give rhythmic sense to the sentences you utter so they are easier on the ear of the listener. In manga, of course, they appear often. Students may be familiar with Pikachu from the Pokémon franchise. The name "Pikachu" consists of two onomatopoeias: $\forall \mathcal{D} \mathcal{P}$ (flash of light) and $\mathcal{F} \mathcal{D}$ (squeaky noise that a mouse makes).
